The camp is located on Los Lances beach, 4 kilometers from the town of Tarifa in the Natural Park of the Strait. We set up our camp at Camping Rio Jara. We'll be there for two sessions throughout July. We've reserved a special area that gives us privacy to create a family-like atmosphere among kids and counselors. We'll be staying in tents, embracing a simple lifestyle that brings us closer to nature. Right in front of our camp is the sea and the beach, which provides a vast space for our sports program. Many days, we'll enjoy musical evenings, dinners, or unforgettable sunsets there.

Sotogrande is renowned worldwide. It combines quality and luxury in its marina. We'll spend 5 days sailing there, with a total of 10 hours, and just a few steps away at the paddle and tennis club, another 10 hours of lessons by professionals blending fun and learning perfectly.
