The camp is located at Los Lances Beach, 4 kilometers from the town of Tarifa, in the Strait's Natural Park. We set up our camp at Camping Rio Jara. We offer two sessions throughout July. We reserve an exclusive area to create a family atmosphere among kids and counselors. Our accommodations are in tents, providing a simple lifestyle that connects us closely with nature. Right across from our camp are the sea and the vast beach, perfect for sports activities. Many days we enjoy musical evenings, dinners, or unforgettable sunsets there.

We form a family-like group of 20 to 50 campers aged 14 to 17. A team of experienced counselors leads this teen camp. During the session, all duties are shared cooperatively, creating a balanced and fun experience. The camp is built together, starting with an empty space that becomes filled with a kitchen, dining area, lounge, and tents that the campers learn to set up themselves.

Option A: Kitesurfing Course with the official OZU school (20h)

We've chosen the Ozu school for the kitesurfing course. This activity requires expert professionals and state-of-the-art equipment. A ratio of 1 instructor for every 4 students ensures responsible practice. The team consists of instructors with over 10 years of experience.
